Year 1 Phonics Screening

Next week our Year 1 children will sit their Phonics Screening Check with Miss Clarke. The Year 1 phonics screening check is not a formal test, but a way for teachers to ensure that children are making sufficient progress with their phonics skills to read words and that they are on track to become fluent readers who can enjoy reading for pleasure and for learning. It is a school-based check to make sure that children receive any additional support promptly, should they need it. It is not a stressful situation because the teacher will be well equipped to listen and understand children's level of skills. We will let parents know the results at the end of the summer term.

ELS Phonics

How can you help at home?

Children will only read books that are entirely decodable, this means that they should be able to read these books as they already know the code contained within the book. We only use pure sounds when decoding words (no 'uh' after the sound). Ideally, children should practice reading their book four times across the week working on these skills:

Decode – sounding out and blending to read the word. **Fluency** – reading words with less obvious decoding. **Expression** – using intonation and expression to bring the text to life!

We must use pure sounds when we are pronouncing the sounds and supporting children in reading words. If we mispronounce these sounds, we will make reading harder for our children.

Practicing the sounds

You can help your child practice the sounds they have been learning at school. Charts will contain a list of sounds in the order they'll be taught. You can show these to your child along with the picture to help them remember.

Blending

After children learn to read some sounds separately, they can start blending them together to form simple words. Take a look at the video below for ideas on how you can practice word blending with your child.

Reading decodable books

Your child will bring home reading books with words that use the sounds they have been learning that week. You may hear these reading books called 'decodable books'. Use the prompts inside the front and back covers to enjoy the book together and help your child practise reading.


