
Wear Red Own Clothes Day

The closing date for high school applications is 31st October, 2025 and it is essential that you make your application using the link:- www.lancashire.gov.uk/schools before deadline date. Late applications may mean that your child isn't awarded a place at the high school of their choice. Please ensure that you have received an email confirmation of your application.

If your child is baptised Catholic and you wish them to attend a Catholic high school, you will also need to complete a supplementary form which is available from the high school. The high school will also require a copy of your child's Baptism Certificate.
